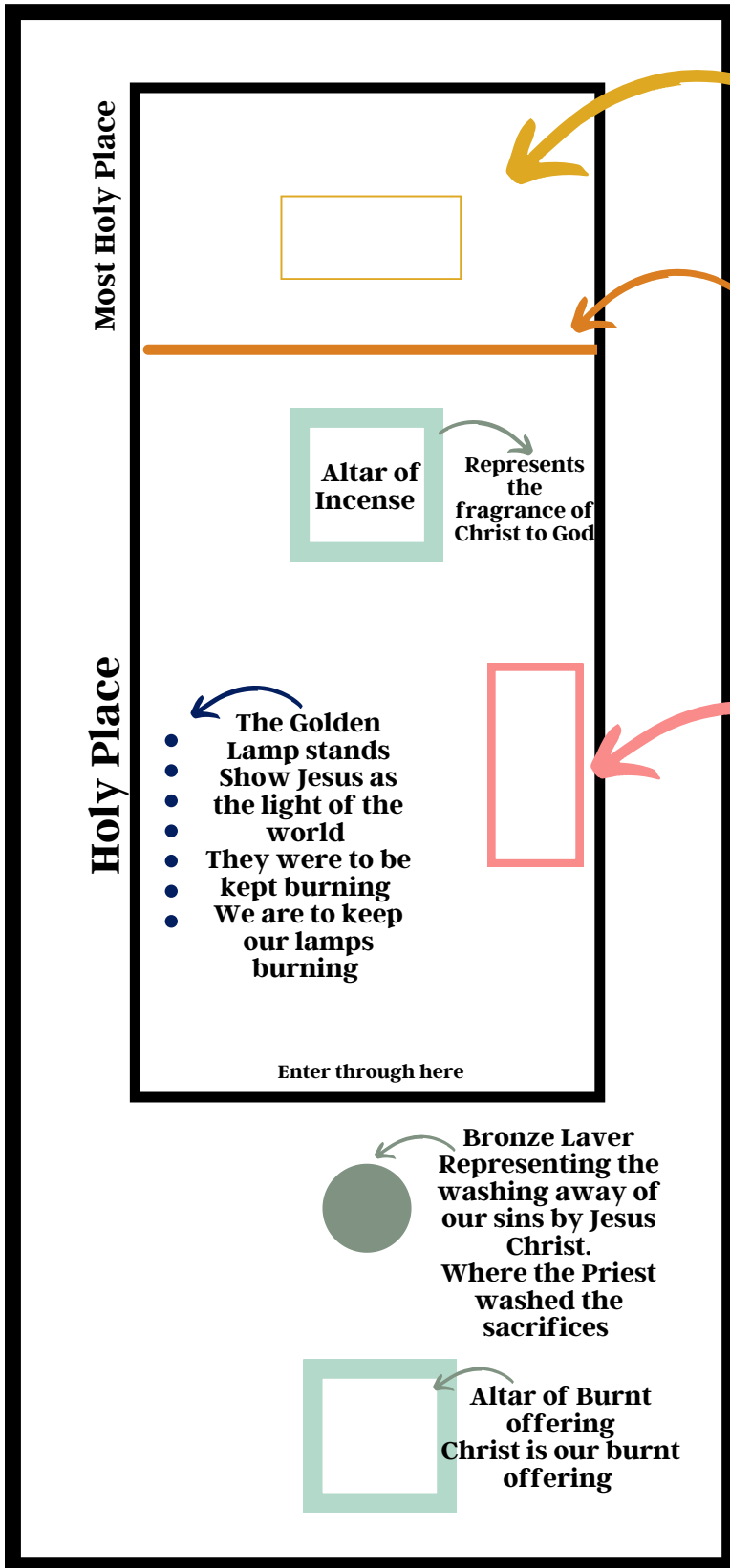


*The Tabernacle was to provide a place where God was able to dwell among His people. Today we have the Holy Spirit dwelling inside of us.*

**Inside the Ark of the Covenant**

- Inside was “the testimony” which would contain the tablets of the law (10 Commandments), Aarons staff and a jar of manna(bread). It was a reminder of all the Lord had done for them.
- on top would be the mercy seat which is where the blood of the sacrifice was placed by the Highest Priest once a year on behalf of the people. The Mercy Seat is where judgement and grace met. Jesus Christ covered sin once and for all when He died and shed His blood for us.



Most Holy Place

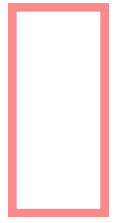
Holy Place

Represents the fragrance of Christ to God

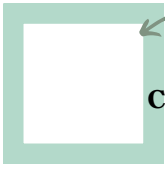
- The Golden Lamp stands Show Jesus as the light of the world

Altar of Burnt offering Christ is our burnt offering

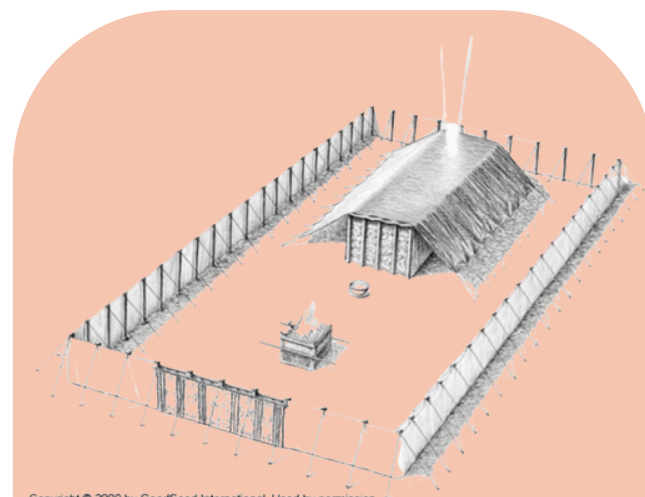
- Ark of the Covenant**
- Made of gold
  - Spoke of God's deity (gold) and humanity (wood)
  - On top of it was a mercy seat which shows Jesus Christ as our mercy seat

The Veil the separates the most Holy Place from the Holy Place.

A reminder that sin separated them from God

This veil was torn when Jesus died on the cross.

- Table of the showbread**
- 12 loaves
  - 6 on each side of the table
  - Represents the daily bread we need to have to be filled with the bread of life.
  - We should always be sitting down at the table for fellowship and communion with God
  - Get in God's presence regularly
